Dear Senator Tillis, Senator Budd, Representative Ross, and Representative Foushee:

This is in response to your September 6 letter to Postmaster General DeJoy concerning the mode of delivery for addresses within the Research Triangle Park (RTP) in the Durham area.

Officials at U.S. Postal Service Headquarters and our North Carolina District continue to work with the RTP Foundation and RTP tenants on establishment of centralized mail delivery for addresses within the RTP. Postal Service officials met with RTP Foundation representatives and RTP tenants on September 29 to discuss the planned mode of delivery conversion.

Completion of the mode of delivery conversion is contingent on multiple factors, including receipt of assigned street addresses from the local government; receipt of tenant election to convert to centralized delivery; incorporation of new street addresses within the Address Management System; receipt of a valid Change-of-Address order from tenants authorizing centralized mail delivery; installation of cluster box units; and execution of a mode of delivery agreement, among other things. The Postal Service will continue to coordinate with the RTP Foundation and RTP tenants through this process.

Thank you for your inquiry regarding mail delivery service in the RTP. If I can be of assistance with other postal issues, please let me know.
