Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Affordable Recovery Housing for Women and Women with Children project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Raleigh, located at One City Plaza, Suite 1200 421 Fayetteville Street, Raleigh, North Carolina 27601. The funding would be used to develop a 17-unit affordable, transitional, recovery-oriented rental housing community to serve women with children and single women who have completed long-term recovery programs. This project is a valuable use of taxpayer funds because it will expand the supply of affordable housing for extremely low-income residents while strengthening the local continuum of care for individuals recovering from substance use disorders. By providing stable, recovery-oriented housing, residents will be better positioned to maintain employment, build rental history, reunite with their children, and transition successfully to independent housing.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2).
